A Church may grow and do a good ministry while simultaneously missing the new opportunity for ministry, staring them in the face. A Christian may go to church on Sunday and forget by Monday that they are called to feed the hungry and cloth the naked. (Matthew 25:35-45) God does not give up on Christians or the church, nor can we as the Church.

All of this is the basis of Grace. The United Methodist Governing Book of Discipline defines grace as "the undeserved, unmerited, and loving action of God in human existence through the ever-present Holy Spirit." (BOD 2016 Par. 102) I think that the little sign sitting on my desk is a great recognition of this. I am asking you all to remember that the grace you give me is not deserved or earned but instead given to me out of love from God and all of you, and more importantly, it is a reminder to me to be patient with myself and everyone else. That same patience I am asking you for, I should freely give to everyone, not just in my office but all I meet.

Let this be our goal as we start this new relationship together, and maybe we should revisit some old relationships that may need some patience.





Greetings! At last, summer is here in full swing. Vacations are happening and my brain has decided to take one also! My mini-lessons will return next month.

SPRC met on June 6 for their last meeting with Pastor Terri. There was discussion regarding who was covering the last Sundays in June and personnel matters. She reported that she and Pastor Bennett had been in conver-




sation quite often. At the time, the website was still being constructed but I see progress has been made. Ellen and Les Hall hosted a welcome supper on June 21 for Pastor Bennett and Kim with SPRC members in attendance also. Thank you to Ellen!

The regular trustee meeting was held on June 8 where there were many items to discuss. The purchase of a robotic vacuum, the uneven sidewalks in the front and a new copier were tabled until the August meeting. The insurance for the contents of the mower shed will be raised from \$1700 to \$40,000 because of the three zero-turn mowers housed in the shed. Liability and the umbrella policy amounts will be increased but by how much will be discussed at the next meeting. New door sweeps on the kitchen doors were installed. There was discussion regarding the fencing to be placed around the new playground area. It was decided that there will be one door into the playground area accessible from the south door of the education wing and one side of the fence will be the church building. Currently, the church has no fire monitoring. A motion was passed to employ a company called EM24, which took over monitoring the Securitas lines, at a cost of \$45 per month. Securitas was the fire monitoring company used prior to the installation of the Ring burglary system. The family of Doc and Mary Smith wish to purchase a living memorial to Joan Cross to be place on the church grounds. The trustees will advise them that a tree placed on the west side of the church would be a welcome addition. There is a blockage in the drainage between the parking lot by the education wing and Prairie Street according to the city. This is the reason the parking lot will not drain after a heavy rain.

Trustees had from the afternoon of June 13 until Pastor Bennett arrived on June 19 around 5:30 PM to ready the parsonage. In addition to the installation of new flooring in the downstairs and the entire upstairs by Helmwood Construction, there were many other projects being completed at the same time. Before the flooring installation could begin, all the parquet floor was removed in the downstairs hallway and all the carpeting and peel and stick flooring in the upstairs was removed. A carpenter was employed to sand one flight of stairs and paint them and to replace the kitchen sink cabinet bottom. The wallpaper in the downstairs bedroom was removed and the walls were repainted. A big thanks to Jim Pattenaude for the steamer. The wallpaper would still be there if we had to scrape it and that layer of paint off! The upstairs master bedroom and the bathroom were repainted also. The electrical outlets, switches and cover plates were replaced in these rooms. A new vanity and sink were purchased and installed in the upstairs bathroom. Walls and kitchen cabinets were washed, floors were vacuumed and mopped, and appliances cleaned. The basement was swept. Windows were washed. Patching was done on some of the walls and the paint touched up. All the broken window weights were repaired. The light in the front yard was fixed as was the light in the upstairs closet and there is now electric power to the doorbell. The dryer in the basement


was completely cleaned out. The door jamb to the back door was repaired as was one of the cabinet doors that had been broken. The filters in the furnace and air conditioner were cleaned and/or replaced as needed. The door handle to the walk-in door of the garage was replaced. The back door to the house was repainted. The gutters were cleaned and tree branches that were touching the roof were trimmed. The entire



yard was weeded and cleaned up. New blinds were purchased by a church member and many, if not most, of the supplies required for the repairs mentioned above were donated by other members. It was a group effort to get all this done in such a short time. This project could not have been completed without the generous help and support of so many of our members. THANK YOU from the bottom of my heart. I know the trustees feel the same way.

The Finance committee met on June 18 and there was continued discussion of the mistakes in the reports. The audit, conducted by Mike Ovca, was the main point of discussion. Overall, Mike was pleased with what he saw. However, there were a few points that he brought out. Mike felt that the financial policy of the church needs to be updated. He said there should be reporting on the usage of the debit cards. Overtime hours are not approved prior to working. There needs to be an update to the inventory of the church. The last one was a video completed in March, 2018. He thought it was good that we are updating our insurance coverage. In other business, the committee approved closing the checking account at First Bank (formally First Federal Bank of Tuscola).
